

# Check your corn for rootworm damage:

July 26, 2017



Lodging, tipping over, instability or 'goosenecking' is evident now in fields with rootworm.



Severe rootworm larvae damage to roots; brace roots completely destroyed. Larvae present on plant crown.



Beetle feeding on leaves: “window-paning” and sawdust



Beetles emerging from soil, present on leaves, beginning to fly, 6 mm long, July 24



Yellow sticky traps are now being set up along edges of corn fields throughout the Fraser Valley. Traps will be checked weekly for beetles until late in September.
